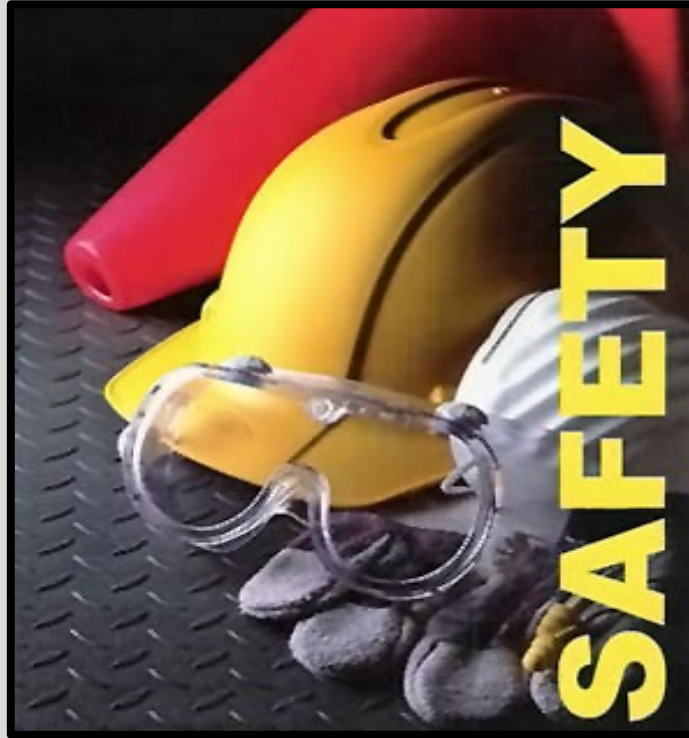


HACI Mechanical Contractors, Inc. is committed to providing our employees with a safe working environment as well as the education and training to work safely.
